# KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

## **CAPITAL PROJECT FUNDS - CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM**

**GENERAL OBJECTIVES:** To oversee the capital improvements program, including ongoing and future projects.

### FY2005 OBJECTIVES:

<u>School Revenue Capital Projects</u> -- to account for capital improvements to schools, funded by revenues from the Borough's General Fund.

**Bond Funded Capital Projects** – Four new bond funded capital projects have been authorized in the past year, they are as follows:

**Solid Waste** In October 2002, voters of the Kenai Peninsula Borough approved the issuance of up to \$12,000,000 of general obligation bonds for planning, designing, site preparations, constructing and equipping a regional solid waste facility located near Soldotna. The issuance and sale of \$7,040,000 will fund the first phase of the project. The first phase of the landfill expansion including clearing 40 acres and excavating over 625,000 cubic yards of material was completed in late 2003. The next phase including the liner installation, leachate and gas collection and treatment, and other improvements will be conducted during May -November 2004. The second phase of the project will occur in approximately 2008-2009 with issuance and sale of general obligation bonds as needed to fund the remainder of the project.

**Central Peninsula Hospital Service Area** In October 2003, voters of the service area approved the issuance of up to \$49,900,000 of general obligation bonds for a major expansion and renovation project to the current hospital. A new master plan and schematic design effort was completed by summer of 2003. The project will be done in three phases; Phase 1, clearing and excavation slated for 2004; Phase 2, construction of a major addition scheduled for 2005 through to 2007; Phase 3 formulating a capital projects and expansion master plan, 2006-2007. This plan is for repairs, improvements, upgrades and expansion to the entire facility.

**South Peninsula Hospital Service Area** In July 2003, voters of the service area approved the issuance of up to \$10,500,000 of general obligation bonds for a \$17,000,000 major expansion and renovation project to the current hospital. A new master planning effort was completed by summer of 2003. Schematic and design development activities for the east-end expansion are underway. Construction documents are expected to be available for bid in late Fall 2004 for a 2005/2006 construction period.

<u>Seward Middle School</u> In October 2002, voters of the Kenai Peninsula Borough approved the issuance of up to \$14,700,000 of general obligation bonds for planning, designing, site preparations, constructing and equipping a middle school for Seward. The project is slated for completion 2005. <u>General Government Capital Projects</u> -- to account for General Government capital improvements funded by revenues from the General Fund.

<u>Service Area Capital Projects</u> -- to account for capital improvements and equipment acquisitions for the service areas. Financing is provided by revenues from special revenue funds, interest earnings, and grant funds.

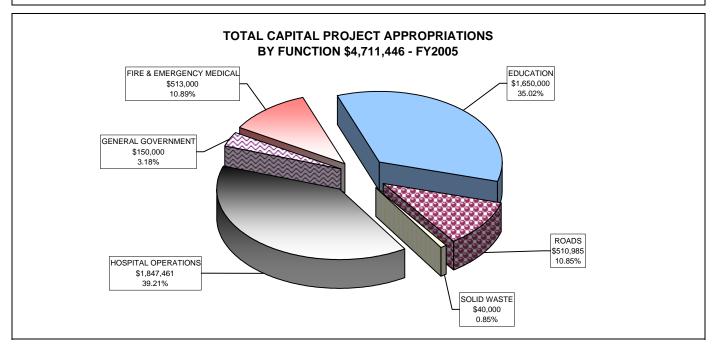

**Maintenance Department** -- Flooring replacement at K-Beach, North Star, Soldotna High, KCHS, Sterling and School District Warehouse. Electrical ballast upgrades at Nanwalek, K-Beach, Soldotna High and Seward High upper and lower gyms. New intercom installation at Sears; new digital control upgrades at KCHS, Nikiski High, Skyview, Soldotna Elementary, North Star, Mt. View, and Soldotna Maintenance Shop; asbestos abatement at KCHS, Soldotna High, Kenai Alternative, Nikiski Elementary, Seward High, and Tebughna; refurbish gym floor at Soldotna High.

<u>Solid Waste Department</u> -- Seldovia Landfill design; transfer site container construction; transfer site electrical service installation; Homer Landfill design and construction of stormwater controls; Homer Landfill safety and code improvements.

PROJECTS PROPOSED and/or UNDERWAY: Anchor Point Remote Station Preliminary Design at Nikolaevsk; Arsenic System Study; CES Station 1 Renovation Design; CES Station 4 Generator & Water Well Plumbing; Kachemak Fire Station Construction; Kenai Middle Bleacher Replacement; Nanwalek School Roof/Drainage; Nikolaevsk School Old Wing Roof Rework; NRE DOT/PF Design; OEM Siren System Upgrades; Seward Middle Construction; Skyview Water System Tankage/Treatment; Soldotna Middle Fire Alarm construction; and Tebughna Teacher Housing.
