**SECTION 5.** That in the Board of Education District 3, Jason A. Tauriainen was elected to a 3-year term, having received the greatest number of votes cast.

**SECTION 6.** That in the Board of Education District 4, Penny Vadla was elected to a 3-year term, having received the greatest number of votes cast.

**SECTION 7.** That in the Board of Education District 6, Virginia Morgan was elected to a 2-year term having received the greatest number of votes cast.

**SECTION 8.** That in the Board of Education District 7, Debbie V. Cary was elected to a 2-year term having received the greatest number of votes cast.

**SECTION 9.** That in the Bear Creek Fire Service Area, Jena Petersen was elected to a Seat E for a 3-year term, having received the greatest number of votes cast.

**SECTION 10.** That in the Joint Operations Board for Central Peninsula Emergency Medical Service Area, Gary Hale was elected to Seat E for a 3-year term, having received the greatest number of votes cast.

**SECTION 11.** That in the Nikiski Fire Service Area, the following were elected, having received the greatest number of votes cast:

Seat E – Judith C. Lund for a 3-year term

Seat G – Tim Daugharty for a 2-year term


**SECTION 16.** That Proposition No. 1A – Proposed Expansion Area, Creating the Western Emergency Service Area was ratified by the voters of the borough.

**SECTION 18.** That Proposition No. 2, Repealing Ordinance 2020-24 was ratified by the voters of the borough.


**SECTION 16.** That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
